
History

MISSO was founded in 1982 by a consortium of faculty including Dr. Michael Parks and students involved with the Management Information Systems department at the University of Houston.



The Point System



- Bake Sales:** 10 Pts

Points are given for volunteering at Bake Parties and Bake Sales (minimum 1 hour)

- Career Mixer:** 20 Pts

- Committee Involvement:** 5 Pts

Committee members will receive 5 pts for each event that they assist with

- Joining a Committee:** 10 Pts

You may join multiple committees and receive 10 points for each.

- Mentorship Mixer:** 15 Pts

Points are awarded for participating in the Mixer as a mentor, mentee, or both.

- Professional Development Workshops:** 20 Pts

Events include the Career Fair Workshop, Case Study Workshop, etc.

- Professional Meetings:** 30 Pts

- Socials:** 10 Pts

- Volunteer at EastSide University:** 20 Pts

- Volunteer Events:** 45 Pts

Why?

The Point System is used to promote **active participation and involvement** of MISSO members that will contribute most to their overall development as professionals, students, and leaders.

MISSO vows to only use points for rewards and not penalties

A student is not required to receive any points to be considered a member.

**Members need at least 60 points to be eligible to vote during officer elections*

***The top two point earners at the end of the semester will receive scholarships.*

How?

At each MISSO event, we will be able to record your attendance when you **'swipe in' with your Cougar Card or sign-in with your PeopleSoft number.**


Our database will automatically calculate your overall points and display it on our 'Master Points' Sheet.



Be Involve! Join a Committee!


- Many of the MISSO officers will have committee members to work alongside them throughout the semester.
